Supplemental clinical data sharing between payers and providers is increasingly key to delivering quality outcomes in health care.

What is supplemental clinical data?

This is data captured real time in medical records and other electronic data sources that you send to us. It supplements data we capture through traditional means, such as claims and encounters. It plays an important role in helping us identify and report to you any gaps in care for your patients with HealthSpring plans.

How to share data with us

The fastest and most efficient way to share this data is by billing Current Procedural Terminology (CPT®) Category II codes, when applicable. We also recommend providing us with direct access to your electronic health record system. Some providers may elect to share data through the Epic Payer Platform, Arcadia or the Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS®) approved template highlighted below.

Which method works best for you?

Epic Player Platform

Epic Payer Platform is a secure and efficient way to exchange clinical data directly within Epic workflows. It helps streamline communication, reduce manual processes, improve operational efficiency and support more timely access to clinical information. The exchanged data can be used to support population health initiatives, HEDIS quality measures, risk adjustment efforts and overall interoperability between our organizations.

You can use this population health tool and clinical data integration program to enhance data sharing with health plans and to access relevant clinical data to help manage patients more effectively.

Providers can share supplemental clinical data with HealthSpring via a proprietary template used to upload data into our HEDIS-certified software.

How we use supplemental clinical data

HealthSpring uses clinical data to create reports that include patient-level information around coding and documentation opportunities and quality outcomes. The reports are refreshed biweekly to include all available data from:

- Approved claims at the time of the refresh
- Epic Payer Platform, Arcadia and the HEDIS clinical file
